



SRTS WHITMORE AVENUE CORRIDOR

P19-003 (ATPL-068)

Project Description:

ATP project to install sidewalks and road improvements for safe pedestrian movements along the south side of Whitmore Avenue from Moore Road to Eastgate Boulevard. The work consists generally of street improvements including but not limited to a pedestrian hybrid beacon signal, curb, gutter, sidewalk, stamped concrete, curb ramps, driveways, HMA pavement, striping, street lights, fencing, storm drain, sanitary sewer, water improvements, and tree removal. Construction is expected to start in Spring 2020. Project is funded primarily with State Funds. Only Measure L funds are reported herein.

Measure L Funds – Bicycle and Pedestrian Project - \$211,958.37

SB1 Road Maintenance and Rehab, Water Service Fund, and Sewer Service Fund


Project Cost:
