EMC Health Foundation Launches a Free Hearing Aid Program for Seniors Starting July 1.

The impact of hearing loss on anyone is tough. Still, as we grow older, it can be devastating. According to the National Council on Aging, hearing loss impacts 1 in 3 people ages 65-74 and nearly half of those 75 and older.

With those statistics in mind, the EMC Health Foundation is partnering with Costco and the Turlock Chamber of Commerce Foundation to offer free hearing tests and hearing aids to qualifying seniors.

“As we all know, growing old is not for sissies, so helping ensure people age gracefully and remain healthy and independent is a priority of our foundation,” said Jeffrey Lewis, President and CEO of the EMC Health Foundation. The last time we launched this program, more than 90 seniors received free hearing tests and hearing aids. Our goal is to continue helping as many seniors as possible.”

Is this program free?

Yes, the EMC Health Foundation is using its charitable funds to support this program.

Are there income requirements?

Individuals and families should not have a household income greater than 500% of the federal poverty level. Please see the chart below:

Federal Poverty Guidelines for 2025 Monthly Income

How do I sign up for the program?

1. Contact the Turlock Chamber Foundation office at 209-632-2221 and ask for the hearing aid coordinator, who will take down all your information. Regardless of how you sign up, you must come to the Turlock Chamber Foundation office and pick up the form you take to Costco for your free hearing aid test and Costco gift card.
