In compliance with the requirements of Government Code § 54970 – 54974 and the Maddy Act, below is an appointment list of existing vacancies and all current board, commission, and committee members whose terms will expire throughout the 2026 calendar year.

PLANNING COMMISSION (4-year term)

This commission acts as a quasi-judicial board for land use management such as zone changes, appeals and long-range community development planning. To be eligible for appointment to the Planning Commission one must be a resident of the City of Ceres, and if a City Planning Commission member moves his place of residency from the City of Ceres, it shall be considered an automatic termination of that person's position as a Planning Commission member. Meetings are held the first and third Monday of each month at 6:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers.

MEASURE H CITIZENS' OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE (3-year term)

Section 3.10.160 of the Ceres Municipal Code established a Citizen's Oversight Committee to monitor the expenditure of revenue collected from the Measure H sales tax and report to the citizens and the City Council. The committee consists of five (5) members appointed by the City Council. No member may serve more than two consecutive three-year terms. The committee meets no less than two times per year.
